EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the resident and nonresident goat hunting seasons in the Skagway, Alaska portion of hunt area RG024, north and east of the East Fork of the Skagway River to the Canadian border in Game Management Unit 1D. This order takes effect at 11:59 pm, Tuesday, October 20, 2009.

REGULATORY TEXT:

Therefore, the provisions of 5 AAC 85.040, HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR GOAT, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting goat in Unit 1(D):

Unit and Bag Limit	Resident Open Season (Subsistence and General Hunts)	Nonresident Open Season
(1) Unit 1(D), that portion north and east of East Fork of the Skagway River to the Canadian border.	Sept. 15–Oct. 20 (General hunt only)	Sept. 15–Oct. 20

1 goat by registration permit only.

The remainder of Unit 1D mountain goat seasons, other than those previously closed by emergency order, are not affected by this emergency order.

JUSTIFICATION:

Biologists have set a guideline harvest objective of 1-2 points (1-2 goats) for the area. As of Tuesday, afternoon October 20, 2009, the reported harvest is 1 male goat and 1 female goat (3 points). Because the guideline harvest level has been exceeded an emergency order is being issued to close the goat hunting season in the East Fork of the Skagway River portion of Unit 1D at 11:59 pm, Tuesday, October 20, 2009.
