



Run Timing — Anchorage, Whittier, Seward

Peak of the run is midway between the dates given

Ship Creek	King Salmon	Late May through season closure in mid-July.
	Silver Salmon	Mid-July through early September.
Campbell Creek	Rainbow Trout	Entire Year.
	Dolly Varden	Entire Year.
	Silver Salmon	Late July through September.
Stocked Lakes	Rainbow Trout, Arctic Char, Arctic Grayling, Landlocked Salmon	Entire Year.
Bird Creek	Silver Salmon	Late July through Mid-August
	Pink Salmon	Early July through mid-August, even-numbered years (2006, 2008, etc.).
Twentymile River	Smelt (Hooligan)	Late April to June 15.
	Silver Salmon	Mid-August through October.
Whittier	King Salmon	Early June through Late June.
	Silver Salmon	Early August through mid-September.
Resurrection Bay	King Salmon	Returning fish: late May to late June; “feeder” kings: all year.
	Silver Salmon	Early July to late September.
	Smelt, Herring	1st-2nd week April through end of May.

These streams all have regulations affecting tackle, hours open to fishing,
 areas open to fishing, and bag limits.
